

## **Amateur Radio NLE2011 Timeline**

### **Excerpted from the NLE**

**Monday, May 16**, will focus on Assessment and Communications. On Day 1 of the exercise, every effort will be made to establish communications with as many counties, businesses and community service agencies as possible. We will be utilizing different forms and types of communication networks and resources to accomplish that goal. Efforts will also be focused on conducting community and infrastructure assessments. Some possible options for participation include:

- Conduct a call down exercise in your community or within your business organization and verify that contact information on file is valid and that the individual called could respond to the community or business EOC.
- **Mobilizing amateur (HAM) radio operators and have them make contacts with other amateur radio operators within your region and also with the Commonwealth Emergency Operations Center.**
- Conduct an assessment exercise in your community. Assign specific infrastructure to specific individuals and have them verify they have reached the location and confirm the condition of the infrastructure. Select a section of your community and have assessment teams conduct door to door assessments and complete the required paperwork on the assessment process. Once your assessment is complete, total your simulated findings and report them to the Commonwealth Emergency Operations Center.

### Monday 16 May 2011 (EOC) (Local Times are EDT)

- 0900-1100 (1300-1500Z) Install Airborne Repeater – Patrick Compton KF4FMZ  
VHF 146.595 MHz PL 123.0 - UHF 446.875 MHz PL 123.0
- 0900-1300 (1300-1700Z) Monitor ARES Frequencies from County EOC's – 7228.0  
See ARES Plan and NAI List (No Active Net Will Be called from the EOC)
- 0900-1300 (1300-1700Z) EchoLink Monitor Brooks KY4KY-R 146.70 PL 79.7 – 343205 (OR)  
EchoLink Monitor Richmond KF4REN-R 146.865 PL 192.8 - 451988
- 1330-1600 (1730-2000Z) Airborne Repeater VHF/UHF being flown as part of an airport inspection mission  
VHF 146.595 MHz PL 123.0 - UHF 446.875 MHz PL 123.0  
Altitudes will vary. Users should transmit on VHF and listen on UHF.  
If a net control station does not answer then users are authorized to return the call on UHF. The radio will work both ways. PL IS REQUIRED.  
We expect that the APRS transmitter will work (hopefully)
- 0900-2100 (1300-0100Z) The EOC will accept Winlink Pactor Email all day.)
- 0900-1500 (1300-1900Z) HF Net – KY ARES, KY Counties, and CUSEC States 7228.0 LSB.  
*This is TBA and May Not Happen Due To Flooding*
- 1400-1500 (1800-1900Z) CUSEC MARS Net (CUSEC Net Control) MARS Members are briefed
- 1400-1500 (1800-1900Z) FNARS Net (FEMA National Net Control) (FEMA HF Radio Net)
- 1430-1500 (1830-1940Z) FEMA FNARS Net (Region IV) ALE – Chat – Voice (FEMA Radio Net)
- 1800-1930 (2200-2330Z) ARES VHF – UHF Simplex Net (EOC will Monitor 146.55)
- 1900-1930 (2300-2300Z) Teleconference ARES Regions and MARS Open to KY ARES EC's Assistant DEC's, DEC's all Joint MARS Staff  
Call 1-866-241-5471 and enter 1709# to join the call
- 1930-2100 (2330-0100Z) ARES Statewide Net on 3972.5 LSB  
OBJECTIVE
1. The Net will be called by KY4EOC and will follow the KEN guidelines.
  2. Districts will be called in numerical order and DEC's and Assistants should report the status of their respective counties and NAI's.
  3. EC's and Assistants are encouraged to report for their district in the absence of a DEC. Finally, all other ARES members are requested to check into the net per the roll call protocol.
  4. Any Licensed HAM and/or EOC may Check In to this net
  5. **The purpose of the net is to gather disaster information from your county, further the use of amateur radio for emergency communications and to foster amateur radio as a hobby.**
